FOREST PARK

- Do drive and park with caution as there may be small children, fairies and trolls about.
- Dogs are not allowed in the Adventure Playpark and must be 'under control' at all times in the rest of the Forest Park. Dog fouling is strictly prohibited.
- This is an area of natural terrain so appropriate outdoor clothing and footwear are recommended. The Playpark and The Giant's Lair are steep in places but are accessible by wheelchair users and children's buggies.

MOUNTAIN TRAILS

- Slieve Gullion Trail
Circular and strenuous (15.3 km/9.5 miles)
This trail is for experienced walkers looking for a challenge, you will need a map to navigate it.
- Summit Trail
Linear and strenuous (4.7km/2.9 miles)
Starts and finishes at Mountain Carpark (access via Scenic Drive)
- Blue Trail
Circular and moderate (12.9 km/8 miles)
- Green Trail
Circular and moderate (8 km/5 miles)
- Ring of Gullion Way
This is a two-day walking route which passes through Slieve Gullion Forest Park. Circular and strenuous in parts (Total distance 58 km/36 miles)

FAMILY FRIENDLY TRAILS

- Giant's Lair Trail (Hawthorn Hill Nature Reserve)
Circular and easy (1.6 km/1 mile)
- Sensory Trail
Linear and easy (1.8km/1.1 miles)
- Black Trail (inc. Red Squirrel Safari)
Linear and easy (4.8 km/3 miles)
