
# ReiMAGINE arts festival 2021

The **Reimagine Arts Festival** is proud to be hosted and presented by writer, performer and Newry native, Rozlyn Sheridan.


We join Rozlyn each day as she guides us through our daily events. All presented from the grounds of Derrymore Estate, Bessbrook.
